

COLONIAL HERITAGE GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds – Defined by the inside points of large white stakes and/or the inside edge of orange construction fences.

Ball lost or out of bounds: alternative to stroke and distance, Model Rule E5 – The committee has adopted this optional rule which allows a player to take relief as designated by rule with a two-stroke penalty, provided the ball is not in a penalty area and no provisional ball has been played.

Native Grasses - All native grasses longer than the primary rough are considered a red penalty area. The edge of the penalty area is defined as the line where the rough meets the native grass. The player may play the ball as it lies or take relief under Rule 17.1d under penalty of one stroke.

Animal Hoof Prints –Free relief is permitted per Rule 16-1b/c for a ball in an animal hoof print in the waste area on the 12th hole.

Drop Zones – Drop zones exist for all tee shots and/or approach shots that have a forced carry. The drop zones are all on the green side of the forced carry. Players may use these drop zones under penalty of one stroke. Drop zones will be marked by white paint. Holes affected: 4, 5, 6, 7,13, 14, 16, 17 and 18.

No Play Zones – The Juniper bed on the left side of hole 13 green, the flower bed behind hole 14 green and the flower bed behind hole 15 green are all no play zones. Players **MUST** take free relief per Rule 16-1b.

Ground Under Repair – areas on the golf course considered GUR will be identified with white paint. Free relief is in accordance with Rule 16-1b.

Mulched areas – players are permitted optional free relief from mulch beds to the right of the fairway on the 4th and 12th holes. Relief is provided per Rule 16-1b.

Bridges – bridges that are not in a penalty area or out of bounds are considered immovable obstructions. Free relief is provided under Rule 16-1b.

Irrigation near putting greens - When a ball lies in a closely mown area within two club-lengths of a sprinkler head or other part of the irrigation system that lies in a closely mown area within two club-lengths of the green, the player may lift and drop the ball, without penalty, at the nearest point of relief.
