

Cape Royal Golf Club Member Code of Conduct and Separation Guide

A. Any Annual Pass Member whose conduct or the conduct of the Member's family or guests shall be deemed by the Management to be improper or likely to endanger the welfare, safety, harmony or good reputation of the Club, its employees, or its Members, may be suspended, or expelled from the Club without refund.

B. Subject to the requirements stated, the Management shall have full power and authority to suspend or expel any Member, or to take any other appropriate action, for any infraction or conduct, which in the sole discretion of the General Manager, warrants imposition of any such penalty. The decision of the General Manager shall be final.

C. In the event any person entitled to use the facilities of the Club shall conduct themself in a disorderly or otherwise improper manner while on the premises of the Club, the appropriate Club authority (General Manager, Assistant General Manager, or Head Golf Professional) may in their sole discretion issue a warning to such person or eject them from the premises and forbid them to use the facilities of the Club until the violation has been reviewed by the General Manager. In such case, a complaint shall be made to the General Manager within twenty-four hours after the occurrence of the violation.

D. The General Manager shall, at their sole discretion, have the right to suspend or terminate the Annual Pass Membership of any individual for non-payment of any fee, charge, or other indebtedness.

E. No Annual Pass Member shall be suspended or expelled without first being given the privilege of a hearing before the General Manager except for suspension or expulsion for non-payment or other debt to the Club.

F. Complaints by Annual Pass Members concerning other Members' or guests' failure to abide by Club Rules, policies or standards of conduct should be brought to the attention of the General Manager, Assistant General Manager or Head Golf Professional.

G. All players that use carts from our fleet will share or pair up as of Oct 1st, 2025.
