As you may have noticed, the Club House is currently closed and will be until further notice. This is a necessary step for engineers and designers to evaluate the space for these exciting upgrades as well as required inspections of the structure due to the recent storms.

As part of the ongoing effort by Middlesex County to elevate the player experience, starting with recent renovations at Tamarack East and West Course in 2020—the County is now reviewing concepts to improve and modernize the Raritan Landing Club House to better serve its players and guests.
