About Thursday 'League Event Play Dates'

*May - October -- blocked tee times: 9 – 11 a.m.

These League events' start times vary throughout the season but will fall within our Thursday blocked tee times. Be sure to check your email and the bulletin boards for the upcoming LLGA events. For each 'League Event Play Date,' registration is with the Event Host — NOT the Pro Shop. The Event Host's contact info is listed in the event-related email and on MS bulletin boards. Sign up as early as you can. Some events do fill up!

** Thursday 'League Event Play Dates' and 'Open Play Date' Guidelines: Female guests can join us twice per playing season before an LLGA membership is required.

About Thursday 'Open Play Dates'

*May - October -- blocked tee times: 9 – 11 a.m.

Your LLGA membership entitles you to LLGA-blocked Thursday morning tee times all summer. For Thursday's 'Open Play Dates,' please call the Pro Shop (505-955-4400 ext. 4)

and mention that you are an LLGA member. You can ask the Pro Shop to book your foursome tee time, or if you only have a twosome or threesome, ask the Pro Shop to fill in another LLGA member to make a foursome. *Make a new golf friend!*

**Out of respect for the Pro Shop and other golfers, please cancel your tee time if you know you won't be able to keep it. Open Tee times may be booked 7 days in advance (8 days on weekends) and will be released to the public 3 days in advance.

*June, July & August Tues & Fri 'Twilight' 9 Hole rounds -- 5:00 pm shotgun start.

League Play Birdies, One Putts, Ringers & Holes-in-One

Throughout the season, any LLGA member who plays in a designated Thursday 'League Event,' a Thursday Open Play, a Tuesday or a Friday Twilight, can count/track and post her birdies, putts, chip-ins, holes-in-one ... and record your ringer (lowest) scores on each hole.

Here's how to do that:

Birdie Tree - Members record and post any birdie made on **any** LLGA Play Date or Event. An end-of-season prize is awarded to the LLGA Member with the most birdies during the season! The TREE is located on the ladies' restroom wall.

Putting Contest - Keep track of the one putts you make during any LLGA Play Date or Event. Prizes are awarded at the end of the season!

Ringer Board - An oversized 'master' 18-hole scorecard is posted in the restroom for members to record their first LLGA 18-hole round. Throughout the season, each LLGA member updates her hole scores on that 'master scorecard' with any new lower score for each hole. At the end of the season, a prize is awarded for the lowest net and gross scores.

Hole-In-One - All LLGA members can collect a \$50 prize for any hole-in-one made during a League Play Date or Event. WOW!!!!

Most Improved - A prize is awarded at the end of the playing season to the golfer who records the largest drop in their handicap during the playing season. **Keep Track and Record your Scores!!!**
